

How to Discharge Your Patient to Us

Pathways to Care is a licensed Assisted Living Facility that offers short term medical respite care for people experiencing homelessness with acute medical conditions.

*Intakes are accepted **Monday through Friday 9am-5pm***

What we need to make a **quick decision** to accept your patient:

Fax these documents to (407) 388-0478
After review, our intake nurse will call you.

1. Face sheet
2. History and Physical, recent PT notes
3. Current Diagnostic tests if available
4. If being referred to ECC for IV Therapy, then IV Therapy orders are needed

What we need **after accepting** your patient:

1. **Form 1823** (Version April 2021) signed by MD, PA, or ARNP.
2. Discharge medication reconciliation list.
3. Medications: 30-day supply, including OTC meds with patient labels.
4. Agreement letter from the referring agency stating the length of stay desired and level of financial support
5. Durable Medical Equipment needed and provided for the discharged patient
6. Patient Hospital Discharge forms which include list of any follow up appointments.
7. Referrals to Home Health Care, Home Care (PCP Services)
8. Other documents as indicated on a case-by-case basis.

Pathways to Care:

- Is a post-hospital resource to discharge patients, who are experiencing homelessness or at risk for homelessness from: Skilled Nursing Facilities, Rehabilitation Centers, Hospitals, Surgical Centers, Community Health Center/Clinics, and other related agencies.
- We offer on-site case management, discharge planning for permanent housing, applications for SSI/SSDI, ID and food stamps, medication management, establishment of medical providers, 3 meals, laundry care, private transportation to appointments and support obtaining public transit.
